

Reser's "Good Times" Jingle Competition FAQ Updated 4/9/2025

1. What is the deadline to submit to the "Good Times" Jingle Competition?

- a. It's been extended! Groups told us they needed more time, and we listened. We've extended the deadlines for all groups.
- b. Entries can be submitted beginning February 19, 2025, at 12:01 a.m. Eastern Time (ET) through May 11, 2025, at 11:59 p.m. Pacific Time (PT) ("Entry Period").

2. Why is Reser's hosting this competition?

a. Building upon four generations of commitment to family, fun and traditions, this competition is a celebratory musical tribute to all the Good Times we've shared over the last 75 years and the people who have helped build Reser's into what it is today.

3. How many times can a group enter?

a. A single group may submit up to 3 entries.

4. I belong to a high school acapella group; am I eligible?

- a. Unfortunately, the Competition is open to only collegiate vocal groups that meet the following criteria:
 - i. Must be an official vocal group, choir, or class affiliated with a U.S. college or university.
 - ii. Must provide a valid 501(c)(3) organization number (U.S.-based only). *Note*: It can be your groups, or your school's number.
 - iii. Must be eligible to receive prizes through an approved 501(c)(3) organization. (your group or school)
 - iv. Participating group members must represent at least 55% of the total group members.
 - v. Employees, officers, and directors of Sponsor and its affiliates, along with their immediate family members and household members, are not eligible to participate. The Competition is void where prohibited by law.

5. Is there a limit to how many people can be in a vocal group?

a. No, there is no limit on the size of participating vocal groups.

6. How do I know if our group is eligible to receive the cash prize?

a. All registrants must be eligible to receive a gift/prize into an approved 501(c)(3) organization. (This can be your school's.)

7. Where can I find the contest rules?

a. Visit here for complete competition rules.

8. Are instruments allowed when performing the jingle?

a. No. The jingle must be performed fully in acapella style.

9. Approximately how long should the jingle be?

- a. It is recommended the jingle be 30 seconds to one minute.
- b. The jingle should not exceed 2 minutes.

10. What format should we use to record the video?

- a. Participating groups must write and perform an original song in an acapella format (no instrumental accompaniment).
- b. Registrants are encouraged to post on Instagram or TikTok announcing the participation using hashtag #GoodTimesJingle75, tagging @resersfinefoods.

11. Where do I submit our video?

a. Vocal groups are invited to submit original videos of the jingle to www.resers.com/goodtimesjingle75

12. Has Reser's ever had a jingle?

a. It has been many years since we've had one, and we are excited to hear the creativity of participants and award their efforts.

13. Who is judging the competition?

a. A panel of judges will be appointed by Reser's, including Patricia Reser, a philanthropist and arts patron who serves as board chair of Reser's Fine Foods.

14. When will winners be notified?

a. Entries meeting all contest guidelines will be evaluated by a panel of judges appointed by Reser's between May 12, 2025, and June 9, 2025. Winners will be notified by June 12, 2025, and announced upon submission of required documentation.

15. Will all winners be flown out to Beaverton, Oregon to perform?

a. Only the grand prize-winning group may receive an *optional invitation* (including a travel stipend of up to \$20,000) to present the "Good Times" jingle in a live performance at The Reser- Patricia Reser Center for the Arts in Beaverton, Ore.
